INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the construction of the **EUHARLEE ROAD SEWER EXTENSION** will be received by **BARTOW COUNTY, GA** at The Commissioner's Room; Frank Moore Administrative & Judicial Center; Cartersville, Georgia 30120 until 10:00 AM local time, April 11, 2017 and then at said place publicly opened and read aloud.

The Work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and supplies for the construction of a sanitary sewer extension to serve the Euharlee Road area including: approximately 8,500 LF of 8" PVC gravity sewer, 7,500 LF of 8" PVC force main, one duplex sewage pump station and all related appurtenances.

Payment for the work will be made periodically on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment.

Bids must include a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid. All bonds must be countersigned by a Georgia Resident Agent. Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Bid Price must be furnished by the successful bidder before commencing work.

Bidders must comply with Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity" and with the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act (18 U.S.C. 874) as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR, Part 3).

Bidders must comply with all provisions of the "Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act" of 2007. Bids must include a completed Federal Work Authorization Contractor Affidavit as shown in Section CM1.

The right is reserved by the Owner to delay the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of the bids, during which time bids shall remain open and not subject to withdrawal. The right is also reserved to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all technicalities of informalities.
