**INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed bids for the construction of WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS – **GREAT VALLEY PARKWAY WATER MAIN AT HIGHLAND 75** will be received by BARTOW COUNTY, GEORGIA at the Frank Moore Administration and Judicial Building, 135 West Cherokee Avenue, Cartersville, Georgia 30120, in the Commissioner’s Conference Room, until **3:00 P. M. local time, on THURSDAY, June 01, 2017**, and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after 3:00 PM will be returned to the Bidder un-opened.

The Work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary for construction of approximately 1,900 LF of 24-inch DIP water main, 3,200 LF of 20-inch DIP water main, 300 LF 36-inch steel casing (open cut), 4 fire hydrant assemblies, 2 air/vacuum valve vaults, 1 air/vacuum valve manhole, all with related valves, connections, fittings, anchors, appurtenances, traffic control, clearing, erosion control, grassing, landscaping, restoration, pavement replacement, clean-up, hydrostatic testing, flushing, and disinfection.

The Project will be funded by Georgia Environmental Facilities Authority (GEFA) under the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program. Payment for the Work will be made on the basis of Contractor's periodic Applications-for-Payment processed by the Engineer.

In accordance with §O.C.G.A. 43-41-1, bidders must submit a photocopy of their Georgia Contractor License. Contractors must comply with all provision of the “Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act” (§O.C.G.A. 13-10-91 and §O.C.G.A. 50-36-1). The Successful Bidder must certify compliance with all applicable state and federal laws regarding maintaining a drug-free workplace.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, or other security authorized by law, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total base bid. All bonds must be signed or countersigned by a Georgia Resident Agent. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price. The Successful Bidder will be required to certify compliance with federal Executive Order 11246 regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, compliance with federal Labor Standards and Prevailing Wage Requirements (Davis Bacon Wages), and compliance with all other state and federal laws and regulations applicable to funding under Georgia’s Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF).

The right is reserved by the Owner to delay the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of the bids, during which time the bids shall remain open and not subject to withdrawal. The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all technicalities or informalities. If an award, the award will be made to the qualified Bidder whose Total Base Bid is lowest and responsive.
