

**MINUTES  
PUBLIC MEETING  
BARTOW COUNTY COMMISSIONER  
September 14, 2016  
10:00 A.M.**

**Presentations:**

After calling the meeting to order, Commissioner Steve Taylor introduced Mr. Todd Edwards from the Association County Commissioners of Georgia, who presented Representative Paul Battles with the 2016 Legislative Service Award for his efforts in amending the Fireworks Bill (HB727). Representative Battles commended the staff of ACCG for the work that they do for County Government at the State level.

Commissioner Taylor also presented a Proclamation for Georgia Family Connection before moving to business.

**Surplus County Property:**

- 1) The following county-owned property was declared surplus and authorized for sale on GovDeals Internet Auction Service or to otherwise dispose of as deemed necessary and appropriate:
  - 4 vehicles from Sheriff
  - Lawn mower
  - Welding machine
  - Copier
  - Metal Detector/Scanner

**Agreements:**

- 2) A Storm Water Maintenance Agreement with Constellium Industries, located in the Highland 75 Industrial Park, was approved as presented.
- 3) An Appraisal Services Agreement with Simshauser Co. to prepare appraisals for the Glade Road/Dawn's Way Project was approved as presented.
- 4) The Fiscal Year 2017 agreement with DHS/Transit Alliance Group was presented by Transit Director Weldon Dudley. The total contract amount is \$134,902.00. The funding agreement with Transit Alliance Group assists in providing transportation services and deliver meals to homebound residents. Commissioner Taylor approved the agreement as presented.
- 5) Mr. Joseph Kirk, Bartow County Elections Superintendent, presented an amended Election Agreement with Kingston. The amendment removes the requirement to provide advance voting to the citizens of the City of Kingston at the Kingston Precinct. Citizens of Kingston will still have the opportunity to advance vote at the Elections Headquarters in Cartersville. Commissioner Taylor approved the amended agreement as presented.

**Clerk of Court Technology Funds:**

- 6) Commissioner Taylor authorized the Clerk of Superior Court to utilize up to \$100,000 of its Technology Funds to assist the court services in the purchase of audio and video evidence presentation equipment for the courtrooms.

**Acquisition of Property:**

- 7) County Administrator Peter Olson presented documents for the acquisition of property for the Cass-White Road improvements. Mr. Olson noted that the planned improvements will provide safer access to

Cass High School. The improvements are slated to begin in the fall. Commissioner Taylor approved the acquisition and executed the documents as presented.
