

MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING
BARTOW COUNTY COMMISSIONER
FEBRUARY 4, 2009
10:00 a.m.

Commissioner Clarence Brown opened the meeting and introduced Linda Sloan, from L.A.I. Engineering, who presented the Commissioner with a 1908 geological survey map of northwest Bartow, Polk and Paulding counties.

The Commissioner then proceeded to sign the following resolutions:

- Resolution entering into a contract with DOT for right of way acquisition for the Hardin Bridge project.
- Resolution increasing the wireless 911 charge from \$1.00 to \$1.50 per telephone subscriber per month. Mr. Steve Bradley, County Administrator, stated that with the declining revenue in 911 more calls were coming in from wireless numbers than landline, therefore the increase was necessary.
- Resolution exempting county vehicles from the requirements of Georgia House Bill 648 requiring county vehicles to display an identifying decal.
- Resolution filing an application with the Georgia Dept. of Transportation for FY2010 Transit Assistance. Mr. Steve Bradley, County Administrator, stated that federal money would come through the state for reimbursement, but he was unsure of the amount we would be receiving.
- Resolution authorizing the Commissioner to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Cartersville to share equally the cost of road improvements to Cass-White Road, Zion Road and Cass Pine-Log Road. Mr. Steve Bradley, County Administrator, stated that improvements on these roads would be for the commercial traffic from the Corporate Park located on Cass-White Road. He also stated that the County and City were very excited about the project and believed it would attract other industries to locate in our area.
- Resolution authorizing the Commissioner to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Cartersville to share equally the cost of construction and operations of the firing range and the public safety training facility. Mr. Steve Bradley, County Administrator, stated that this project is being paid with 2003 SPLOST collections that were voted in 2002.

Commissioner Brown approved the following Malt Beverage License application:

- BW-162; Get-N-Go 2, LLC, 998 Cass-White Road, Cartersville,
License Holder – Steve Anderson

Zoning Administrator, Ray Sullivan presented the following rezoning applications for Commissioner Brown's consideration:

RZ-1814-09; an application by **Dan and Sharon Shuford** requesting to amend the future land use map and rezone 3.075 acres located on Euharlee Road from C-1 to A-1 to build a single family dwelling. The Planning Commission voted 6-0 to approve the application. **Commissioner Brown approved the application.**

ARZ-1815-09; an application by Greg Reliford requesting to amend the future land use map and rezone 1.2 +/- acres located on Sugar Valley Road from Low Density Residential to Commercial and from A-1 to C-1 in order to bring a legal non-conforming commercial use into compliance. The Planning Commission voted 6-0 to deny the application. **Commissioner Brown denied the application.**

RZ-1817-09; an application by Marion Smith Sr. requesting to amend the future land use map and rezone 27.8 +/- acres located on Burnt Hickory Road from C-1 to A-1 to raise and sell vegetables, shrubs, flowers and fruit. The Planning Commission voted 5-0 to approve the application. **Commissioner Brown approved the application.**

There was no further business. After answering questions from the media the meeting was adjourned.
