

MINUTES
PUBLIC MEETING
BARTOW COUNTY COMMISSIONER
March 3, 2010

Commissioner Clarence Brown called the meeting to order and introduced the following resolutions for adoption:

- Resolution exempting County vehicles from the requirements of HB648 that requires all government vehicles to display identifying decals.
- Resolution authorizing an agreement with the Georgia Board of Regents to construct an entrance and install a traffic signal on SR20 at Georgia Highlands College. County Administrator stated that the Construction of the new Civic Center is now underway on SR20, directly across from the Georgia Highlands campus. The college has requested that an entrance road be constructed at the new civic center facility and a new traffic signal installed. Georgia Highlands has agreed to pay \$150,000 toward the improvements.
- Resolution designating the Bartow County Recovery Zone under Sections 1400U-1, 1400 U-2 and 1400U-3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and granting Recovery Zone Facility Bond allocation received by the county. Boyd Pettit, County Attorney stated that the Georgia Dept. of Community Affairs has made available certain funds under the Recovery Zone Act, of which Bartow County qualifies to receive \$6,660,000. These funds will be allocated to VMC Specialty Alloys, LLC, as the borrower, for the cost of acquisition, construction, installation, rehabilitation and equipping of an approximately 57,500 square foot manufacturing facility to be used for aluminum smelting and related manufacturing and distribution operations. The facility is located at 800 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Adairsville. VMC Specialty Alloys, LLC will pay certain financing costs and cost of issuance in connection with the funding. There will be no debt to the County or to taxpayers. The new facility will bring 60 new manufacturing jobs to the County.

There was no further business. The meeting was adjourned.
