

**RESOLUTION BY THE CARTERSVILLE-BARTOW METROPOLITAN PLANNING
ORGANIZATION POLICY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, as a result of the 2010 Census Bartow County met the definition of an urbanized area large enough to be designated as a Metropolitan Planning Organization, and

WHEREAS, the Cartersville-Bartow Metropolitan Planning Organization (CBMPO) was designated by the Governor of the State of Georgia on February 11, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the CBMPO, working with the local governments situated within Bartow County, agreed to have Bartow County serve as the boundary for its jurisdiction,

WHEREAS, federal regulations require the CBMPO develop a Long-Range Transportation Plan which maintain a twenty-five year planning horizon and,

WHEREAS, the CBMPO Technical Coordinating Committee in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, and the Georgia Department of Transportation has prepared and reviewed the 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan for the years 2016-2040,

WHEREAS, the Technical Coordinating Committee at its January 20, 2016 meeting recommends the approval of the CBMPO 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the CBMPO Policy Committee concurs with the recommendation of the Technical Coordinating Committee that the 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan be approved, this Third day of February, 2016.
