

RESOLUTION
RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION
OF ROADWAYS WITHIN BARTOW COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Cartersville-Bartow County Metropolitan Planning Organization is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for transportation planning within the Cartersville-Bartow County Urbanized Area which includes all of Bartow County; and

WHEREAS, roadways within the County are classified by the federal and state government according to their use for through traffic and land access; and

WHEREAS, a review of the road network takes place at least once every ten years; and

WHEREAS, these proposed changes require ratification by the Georgia Department of Transportation, Atlanta Regional Commission (in part), and Federal Highway Administration before becoming effective,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Cartersville-Bartow County Metropolitan Planning Organization do hereby recommend to the state and federal governments approval of the attached changes to the functional classification of roadways within Bartow County.
