ADOPTION OF CBMPO PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the federal regulations promulgated under the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act, P.L. 112-141 (MAP-21) mandate that Metropolitan Planning Organizations have a Public Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cartersville-Bartow County Metropolitan Planning Organization (CBMPO) has been designated by the Governor of the State of Georgia as the body responsible for the transportation planning process for Bartow County and the municipalities within the County; and
