

INVITATION TO BID

Bartow County Road Department

Project No. **20007**

Bartow County (Owner) will receive sealed bids for all materials, labor, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary for the construction of the **Beavers Drive Roundabout Intersection at State Route 293** until at 3:00 P.M. local time. All bids must be submitted in a sealed manila envelope with the name of the person submitting the bid.

Bids will be opened to the public at 3:00 P.M. on May 28th, 2021 in The Commissioner's Conference Room at 135 West Cherokee Avenue, Cartersville GA. 30120. Bid Proposals can be mailed or delivered to the Commissioner's Office, at 135 West Cherokee Ave. Cartersville, Georgia until 3:00 P.M. local time, May 28th, 2021, and then at said place publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals received after the designated time will not be considered.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held in the Commissioner's Conference Room at 135 West Cherokee Avenue, Cartersville, GA. 30120 on May 21st, 2021 at 3:00 P.M.

The Scope of Work Includes:

Construction of a new roadway segment "Beavers Drive" with a roundabout intersection. The project is approximately 2,500 feet of new roadway. The typical section for the road is an urban 2 lane undivided roadway with curb and gutter and sidewalks. The proposed Beavers Drive roadway will intersect State Route 293 at a proposed roundabout intersection at mile marker 11.3.

The GDOT Standard Specifications Construction Transportation Systems, 2021 Edition, Supplemental Specifications Book, 2016 edition, and applicable special provisions and supplemental specifications apply to the contract.

Bidders submitting bids must be GDOT qualified contractors.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid. All bonds must be countersigned by a Georgia Resident Agent. A Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Bid Price and a Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred Twenty percent (120%) of the Bid Price and a Certificate of Insurance must be furnished by the successful bidder prior to commencing work.

Bidders shall inform themselves of and comply with all conditions and specifications contained in the bid package, contract, related documents and State and Federal Laws, and moreover in specific to the Contract Conditions.

Payment for the work will be made on a monthly basis and within 30 days of the date in which billing is received. Applications for payment should be submitted on or before the first of each month and will be approved for payment by the OWNER on the basis of work in place.

PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PICKUP ON OR AFTER APRIL 30TH, 2021 and can be may be reviewed at the following location:

Bid Documents may be obtained from Southland Engineering for a non-refundable fee of \$350 for a printed and/or electronic copy of the design drawings.

One contract shall be awarded covering all work and the maximum time for completion shall not exceed 365 consecutive calendar days from the start date specified in the Notice to Proceed. Bidders must agree to pay liquidated damages as specified in the contract documents for delays or extension in construction time. The anticipated Start Date will be June 4th, 2021.

In accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d-42 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, Bidder shall insure that employees and employment applicants are not discriminated against because of race, color, creed, sex, or national origin.

Bidders must also comply with the Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act (O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1) and the Federal Work Authorization Program (O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91). Contractor and Sub-Contractor Compliance Affidavits must be completed and submitted as a part of the bid documents in order to be considered for this project.

The right is reserved by the Owner to delay the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of opening of the bids. The right is also reserved to reject or accept any and all bids in whole or in part and to waive any and all technicalities of informalities.
