

A RESOLUTION OF THE BARTOW COUNTY COMMISSIONER FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF INSTALLATION PERMITS FOR MANUFACTURED HOMES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONER HELD ON AUGUST 9, 2017.

**WHEREAS**, Bartow County seeks to re-examine its permitting process for manufactured homes and to review other ordinances that apply to such homes; and

**WHEREAS**, temporary moratoriums are a lawfully-recognized method to preserve the status quo while a jurisdiction examines and reviews its regulatory structures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner desires to impose a moratorium on the issuance of installation permits under Sec. 18-120 of the Code of Bartow County for a period of four months, ending December 6, 2017 unless earlier terminated by action of the Commissioner;


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED**, by virtue of the authority vested in the Bartow County Commissioner that no installation permits shall issue, nor shall any applications for installation permits be accepted, for manufactured homes under Sec. 18-120 of the Code of Bartow County until December 6, 2017 unless this moratorium is lifted earlier than such date. The intent of this moratorium is to prevent the location or relocation of any new or used manufactured home in the County during such period as the County is reviewing its regulations of manufactured homes.
