

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the construction of WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENTS – OLD ALABAMA ROAD UTILITY RELOCATION - PHASE II, will be received by BARTOW COUNTY, GEORGIA at the Frank Moore Administration and Judicial Building, 135 West Cherokee Avenue, Cartersville, Georgia 30120 in the Commissioner’s Conference Room until **3:00 PM local time, on THURSDAY, APRIL 29, 2021**, and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after 3:00 PM will be returned to the Bidder un-opened.

The Work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary for construction of relocated water and sewer facilities in connection with GDOT’s Old Alabama Road Project – Phase II, P.I. 621410:

**Division One:** Approx. 8,280 LF of 16-inch DIP water main, 2,260 LF of 12-inch DIP water main, 4,280 LF of 8-inch DIP water main, 820 LF of 24-inch steel casing (open cut and bored), 80 LF of 20-inch steel casing (bored in place), 1040 LF of 16-inch steel casing (open cut and bored), 14 fire hydrants, one minor stream crossing, and 55 service re-connections; all with related, flushing, hydrostatic testing, and disinfection, traffic control, clearing, erosion control, grassing, restoration, pavement replacement, and clean-up.

**Division Two:** Approx. 840 LF of 18-inch DIP gravity sewer, 715 LF of 18-inch PVC gravity sewer, 410 LF of 36-inch steel casing (open cut and bored), and 8 manholes; all with related fittings, connections, appurtenances, traffic control, clearing, erosion control, grassing, restoration, pavement replacement, and clean-up.

All Work must conform to the requirements of the Georgia EPD General Permit GAR 100002. The Project will be funded by Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) under the State Revolving Fund (SRF) program. Payment for the Work will be made on the basis of Contractor's periodic Applications-for-Payment processed by the Engineer.

Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained during normal work hours at the office of Sweitzer Engineering, Inc., until 72 hours before the bid opening and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$275 per set picked up or \$300 per set shipped via UPS or FedEx ground.

In accordance with §O.C.G.A. 43-41-1, Bidders must submit a photocopy of their Georgia Contractor License. Contractors and comply with all provisions of the “Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act” (§O.C.G.A. 13-10-91 and §O.C.G.A. 50-36-1). The Successful Bidder must certify compliance with all applicable state and federal laws regarding maintaining a drug-free workplace. The Successful Bidder will be required to certify compliance with federal Executive Order 11246 regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, compliance with federal Labor Standards and Prevailing Wage Requirements (Davis Bacon Wages), and all other state and federal laws and regulations applicable to funding under Georgia Environmental Finance Authority's State Revolving Fund (SRF) programs.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, or other security authorized by law, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total base bid. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price.

The right is reserved by the Owner to delay the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of the bids, during which time the bids shall remain open and not subject to withdrawal. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any and all technicalities or informalities. If an award is made, the award will be made to the responsible, qualified Bidder providing the lowest, responsive Total Bid for each Division.
